POST-WHITE PAPER ANALYSIS : FORTHCOMING EVENT

MORNING SEMINAR BY INVITATION & APPLICATION

On 20th June 2007 the Westminster Energy Forum is convening an invitation-only seminar to examine the key outcomes and implications of the forthcoming Energy White Paper. The first half of the morning will incorporate keynote presentations by the DTI Energy Strategy Unit, alongside DEFRA & Ofgem, in order to elicit a frank discussion with c. 90 high level industry, City and NGO representatives of the policy proposals and risk assessments contained within the White Paper. The purpose of this session is to enable the key stakeholders to quickly feedback their thoughts to Government.
